Day 1 Monday 22/05/2017	Arrive in Amman. Transfer to hotel
Day 2 Tuesday 23/05/2017	<p>Jordan</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cave of 7 Sleepers – Story related to Surah Kaaf • Prophets and Sahaba tombs – Prophet Shuaib (AS) and others • Dead Sea and Prophet Lot as • Sahaba Tree (Al Bakoueya’ or ‘Al Safawy’) – Tree against which the Prophet SAW rested on whilst travelling to Syria
Day 3 Wednesday 24/05/2017	<p>Petra (Rose City) One on the 6 Wonders of the Ancient World.</p> <p>Petra, originally known to the Nabataeans as Raqmu, is a historical and archaeological city in southern Jordan. The city is famous for its rock-cut architecture and water conduit system. Another name for Petra is the Rose City due to the colour of the stone out of which it is carved.</p>

Day 5 Friday 26/05/2017	<p>Jerusalem</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jummah in Masjid Al-Aqsa • Tarawih in Masjid Al-Aqsa (subject to moon sighting) • Tour of Al-Aqsa Mosque and Dome of the Rock complex with the main Imam of Masjid Al Aqsa (Shaykh Yusuf Abu Sneina) <p>Tour Includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masjid al-Aqsa • The Dome of the Rock • Tomb of Prophet Sulaiman (AS) • Khanqah (place of meditation and reflection) of Sultan Salahuddin al-Ayyubi (RH) • Prison for the King of the Jinns commissioned by Prophet Sulaiman (AS) • Graves of Sahabas Shidaad ibn Aws (RA) and 'Ubadah ibn Samit (RA) • House of Imam Ghazali (RH) in Jerusalem where he wrote the Ihya Ulum Din • Women’s Madrasah in Masjid al-Aqsa Compound • Tomb of Maryam as • Wailing Wall: Judaism’s holiest site and also where Prophet Muhammad (SAW) tied the <i>Buraaq</i> during the night of ascension

Day 6 Saturday 27/05/2017	<p>Jerusalem Ramadan commences (subject to moon sighting)</p> <p>Old City Tour</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mount of Olives: Mentioned in the Qur'an and the place where Prophet Isa (as) will descend at the end of times. • Tomb of the Sahaba Salman al-Farsi (RA) • Tomb of the Female Ascetic, Rabia al-Basriyyah (RH) • Tomb of Prophet Dawud (AS) • Church of the Holy Sepulchre: This is the place that Christians believe Jesus (AS) was crucified, buried and where he was resurrected. • Masjid Umar bin al-Khattab (ra): The place where he performed Prayer after the conquest of Jerusalem • Short tour of the Islamic quarter including souks near Damascus Gate
Day 7 Sunday 28/05/2017	<p>Hebron & Bethlehem Tour</p> <p>Hebron</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masjid Khalil: Graves of Prophet Ibrahim (as), Ishaq (as), Ya'qub (as) and Sarah (Wife of Prophet Ibrahim) • Tomb of Yunus (AS) <p>Bethlehem</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Church of Nativity: Birthplace of Jesus (AS) • Visit the Wall dividing the cities • Visit authentic Palestine factory making local artefacts
